Hancock County } I Edmund Matthews of the County and
State aforesaid, being weak in body, yet sensible of my mor-
tality remembering that these temporal things which I
have been blessed should be disposed of for the benefit of
my surviving family: I therefore make and constitute as
this is my last will and Testament,

1st I give unto my beloved wife Dicy the Land and plantation
with the Stock & household and Kitchen furniture
plantation tools &c. Except what may be disposed
of hereafter (viz)

2^d I Give and bequeth unto my son, James one young
Sund house, a bed and Furniture & after the decease
of my wife Dicy the Land & plantation where on
I now live.

3^d I Give and bequeth to my Daughter Elizabeth
Laid one Bed & Furniture which she hath in possession

4th To each of my daughters, Dicy, Nancy & Sally
I Give & bequeth one bed & Furniture to Receive
them as they marry or come of age.

5th I nominate and appoint, My Beloved wife Dicy
as Executor & my Brother Elisha Matthews as
Executor to this my last will and Testament, &
that the Children that are now under age that is
Dicy Nancy & Sally have schooling & be raised
& supported on what is lent to my beloved wife &
if any thing be left over and above to be disposed
of in My Wife Dicy shall see cause except what
with her own hands be disposed of, I Witness
